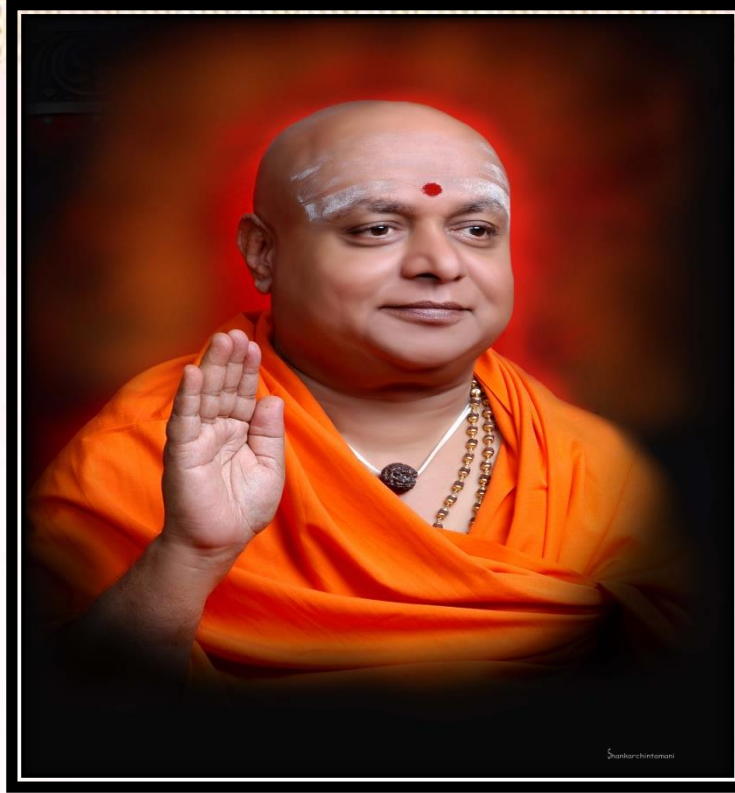

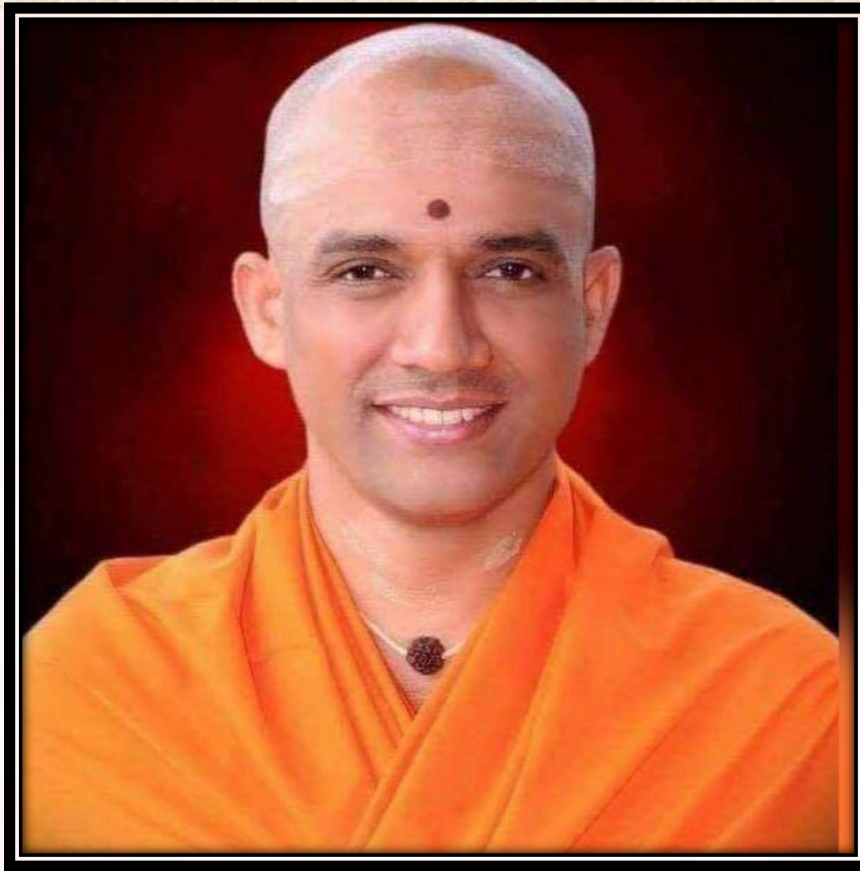

Breaking taboos

Her initiative Project Repeat, a non-profit organisation, aims to provide sustainable and eco-friendly options for menstrual hygiene to government school girls in our country. Riddhi Javalli speaks about her journey to **Husini Lakshminarayanan**, founder of the First Step, a YouTube channel that features interviews of young achievers.

What prompted you to come up with Project Repeat?

Poor menstrual hygiene leads to multiple health complications, particularly among school girls in rural areas. It is one of the big health and educational dropout and of school. Our aim is to identify the problem, understand its root causes, and then create a solution. This initiative is a step in that direction. We started Project Repeat in 2020.

Stigmatisation is growingly and discouragingly. In how do you do it?

Menstrual hygiene doesn't really figure as a point of discussion, especially in villages. Moreover, menstrual hygiene carries stigma in our society. But it is not in my family. I think that independent helped me start this organisation. Girls in rural areas are initially reluctant to talk about menstrual hygiene. But gradually I'm able to talk to them and create awareness about that. In fact, they are actively joining Project Repeat.

Menstrual hygiene doesn't really figure as a point of discussion, especially in villages. Moreover, menstrual hygiene carries stigma in our society. Girls in rural areas are initially reluctant to talk about menstrual hygiene. But gradually I'm able to talk to them and create awareness about that.

What do you think are the qualities of a good leader?

Creating an open line of communication with your team members. I have them and and in some cases I take their opinion too. Good communication skills and efficient work skills make your contribution.

My future is simple - for people to be open about speaking up and instead of it being a taboo on our society. Project Repeat is now growing really in India. My biggest goal is to spread awareness on menstrual hygiene throughout India.

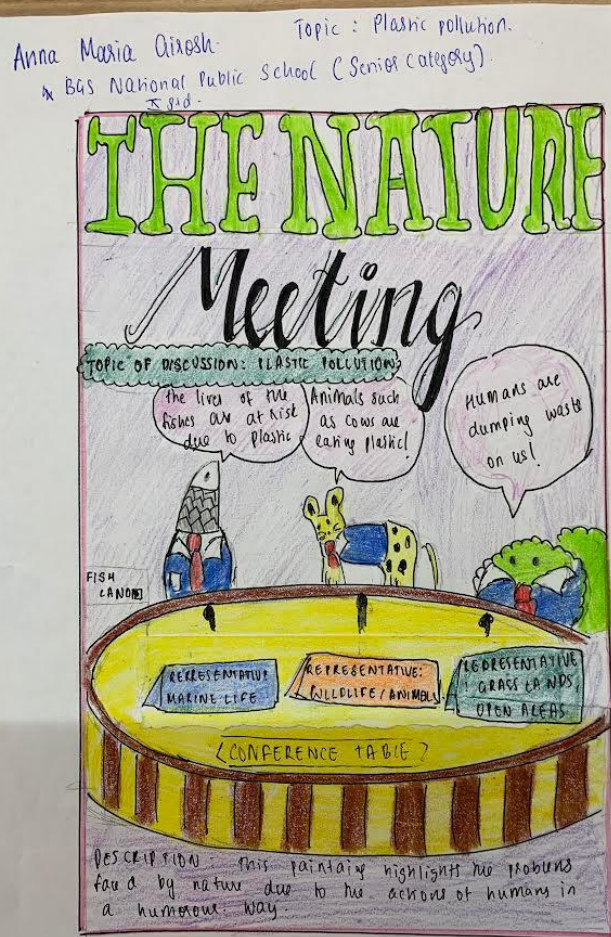

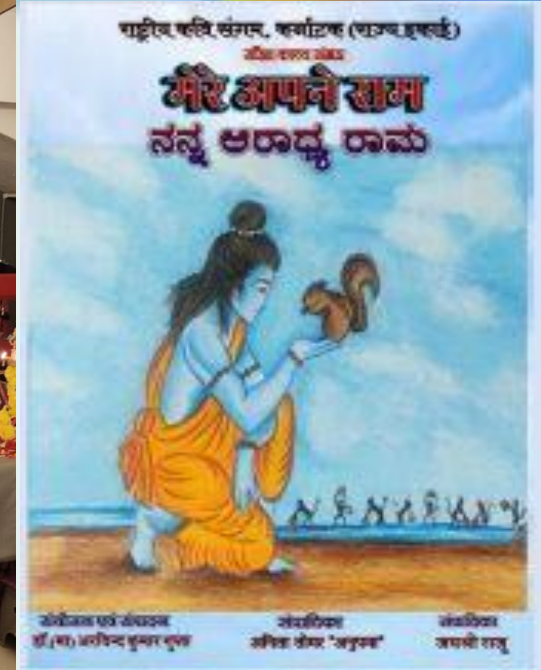

GEARING UP FOR THE REOPENING OF SCHOOLS AFTER THE PANDEMIC:

Rethinking schooling for the 21st century. The state of EDUCATION for peace, sustainable development and global citizenship.

The world of education has shifted faster than it has in the past 100 years. Elementary school students missed their friends, high school students missed their peers. College students missed graduation. Teachers lost their classrooms. What next? Progress can seldom be made by leaps and bounds as the coping gear every class has a class living and we humans are wired to hope for the good that follows the bad. The year 2020 was tough and readiness to say that everyone is now looking forward to 2021 to living in a world of possibility. One amongst is the reopening of the schools, after many months of distance learning which was challenging for children, parents and teachers alike. The challenge is to go back to normal learning process is now dramatically high everyone display a readiness with the new safety measures set by the Government. All the standard Operating Procedures are observed by the school authorities as children enter the school building. Campuses also will come back to life.

School closures have clear negative impacts on child health, education and development. Physical presence in the classroom will make both the teacher and the students emotional. Researchers also believe that distance learning could harm the children over all understanding of school that correct behaviour and moreover this could be damaging their mental health too, highlighting how important it is to be physically present in the classroom to interact with friends and to share opinions about different subjects with each

other and with their teachers. The readiness and enthusiasm of the teachers, parents, children and administration to adapt to the new set of in-school rules makes the safe management of the learning process possible after this covid-19 pandemic reality. It will be hard to gauge the full impact the shutdown is having on children's mental health and well-being until we emerge from it.

Pandemic. Academics. How teachers are preparing for the return to school. I would say it's been this pervasive state of anxiety for every teacher. As the normal school experience has been stopped away from the students. Proper spacing in the classrooms, lots of display resources and getting ready to do to control children about reading sets. I think it's going to be an unfortunate side effect of what we've got back into the school, which actually back the home classes will be more structured. Backward design is helpful in the context. That's an approach in which teachers first identify the skills or knowledge that students gained during the pandemic, or the ones that they should have by the end of the term and then plan a course to help them meet their goals. It gives the teacher to get the opportunity to really tie up on the network. We need to envision that life is a thinking to create a plan of action for 2021 school year. Content in education has to be re-evaluated. There is as much as we can control over but we can prepare our classrooms. The students, in addition to the missed opportunities for learning, can be compensated freedom to say the pandemic has transformed the curriculum, it's a full-fledged teaching model to one driven



by technology. This discussion in the delivery of education is pushing educators to figure out how to drive engagement at scale while ensuring inclusive learning solutions and tackling the digital divide. One, immediate measures are essential to ensure continuity of learning in government schools and universities. Open source digital learning solutions and Learning Management Software should be adopted so teachers can conduct teaching online classes based on office. For the DOWD platform, with reach across all states in India, can be further strengthened to ensure accessibility of learning.

It is also important to reconsider the current delivery and pedagogical methods in school and higher education by systematically integrating classroom learning with a learning model to build a unified learning system. After this time of pandemic, a well-rounded and effective educational practice is what is needed for the capacity building of young minds. School would crowd in support, including technology, that would allow for alien in the community from parents to employees, consistent complement, and bring to life learning experiences in and outside the classroom. It would recognize and adapt to the learning that takes place beyond to walk, regularly assessing students' skills. Rebuilding the promise that education technology-inspired learning for all.
